Powerful Category 4 Hurricane Ida made landfall near Houma, LA on Sunday August 29, 2021.

Inspections at Palm Beach began today. Good news, the roof appears to be intact and keeping out water despite being 90% complete from our previous hurricane and hail damaged. The units have fared well during the torrential rains and wind we encountered. Fewer than 10 units so far have shown any sign of water and they were minimal. Most of the water appeared in and around windows, near sliders and under entry doors. The wind is still blowing briskly and there is still an occasional rain squall today. Thanks to this wind there is a good deal of sand that blew into the parking lot, and we will address it once the sand dries out.

The outdoor pools are currently closed until tomorrow for cleaning. Boardwalks to the beach are sand drifted and partially covered but passible.

Debris from adjacent properties and trash have been policed some today and will resume tomorrow when the wind dies down.
