HURRICANE SALLY UPDATE (As of Tuesday, September 15):

- Voluntary evacuations are encouraged during daylight hours today (Tuesday).
- A curfew will be in place from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. today (Tuesday) and Wednesday. Based on conditions, emergency response may be delayed or interrupted as the weather deteriorates. For emergency calls continue to dial 9-1-1.
- There is significant potential that bridges will be closed as the storm nears shore. Once tropical-storm-force winds are sustained at 45 mph, bridges will close until winds subside or at such time that local emergency management officials deem them safe.

If you missed our last communication, as of September 14th, the Governor of Alabama has issued a state of emergency. Effective at 3 pm the beaches will be closed, and a voluntary evacuation will be in place. **We suggest you consider leaving or changing your travel plans due to the recent updates.** During the height of the storm, emergency services are not guaranteed by local authorities. Security will be onsite and available at 251-
